BEFORE AND AFTER SCHOOL

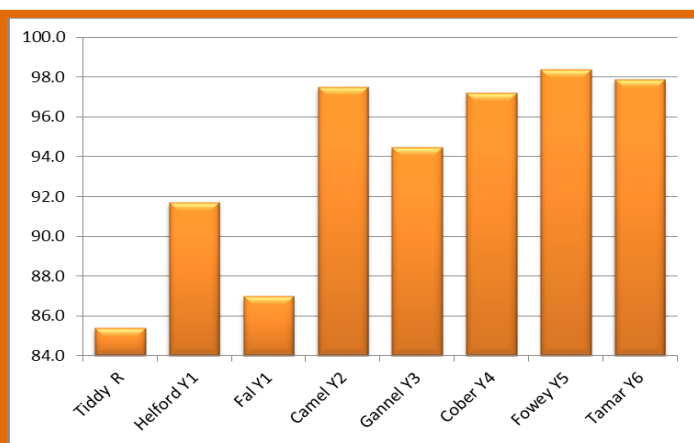
