

CURRICULUM ENRICHMENT

- All pupil premium children receive 25% funding for residential trips. Y2, Y3 / 4 and Y 5 / 6 trips this academic year
- Every class allocated £300 towards costs of day visit for the whole class
- Pupil premium children attended targeted events / trips to develop skills and experiences
- Pupil Premium Personal Budget for each child up to £100 (£50+£25+£25)
- First News provided weekly x6 to enhance global citizenship

TARGETED DEVELOPMENT / ENRICHMENT

- Additional teacher employed to enable targeted support.
- Summer School Y 3 – Y6 for 4 x day during summer holiday
- Story Sacks project to engage families and promote reading for pleasure partly funded by pupil premium
- Children's University membership, partly funded by pupil premium to enhance out of school learning
- Boosters for identified children



FRUIT / MEALS

- All pupils in KS 2 have mid-morning fruit snack provided
- FSM shortfall

ENGAGEMENT USING IT

- IT upgrades including purchase of tablets to enhance pupil access and engage reluctant readers
- Introduction of portable IT in Foundation Stage to enhance parental engagement through web based record sharing

ADDITIONAL SERVICES

- Purchase additional support from Educational Psychologist to ensure provision is delivered in a timely way

STAFFING

- Thrive programme training. All staff to receive on-going CPD.
- HLTA full time to provide targeted interventions including FFT / Thrive / SLT / social skills support
- Provide additional funding to ensure SENDCo remains as full time
- Boosters for children identified as requiring additional support
- Maintain position of a Parent Support Advisor
