It has been a pleasure to welcome so many parents and carers into school this week. Staff enjoyed discussing the reports and the children's learning with you.

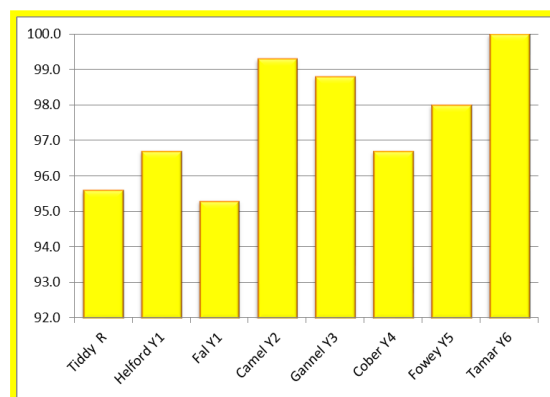
NEW MENU
