members of Year 6 have had additional training to be our Stay Safe Mentors working across the whole school for this year. These pupils help others enjoy their right to relax and play by helping to lead

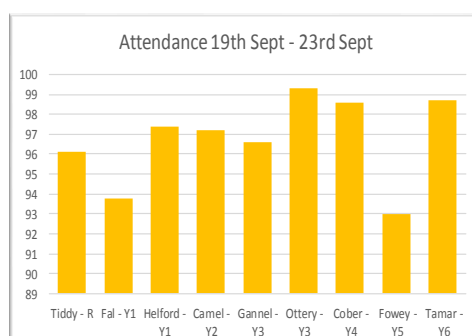
play and games, sorting minor issues as they arise and being a good friend to everyone.
