Y3 Summer Term Topic- The Ancient Egyptians	
TOPIC	This term we will be looking at the Ancient Egyptians. We are studying the way they lived, what they wore and what they ate.
SCIENCE	In science we will be looking at plants, thinking about parts of plants and flowers and life processes. We will look at pollination and how seeds are dispersed.
