This term, linking to our topic, we will be looking at:

- Persuasive writing writing to our MP.
- Factual reports on a local environmental issue.
- Explanation Texts on how animals are classified scientifically.
- Narrative (story) writing linked to our Environment topic
- Poetry linked to our Environment topic.
- Discussion texts on the environmental challenges we face today.

Maths:

This term we will be working on:

- Fractions (including decimals and percentages.
- Measurement (including converting between different units of measurement, time, perimeter and area).
- Ratio and Proportion.
- Algebra (including using simple formulae and looking at number sequences.
- Statistics using line graphs and pie charts.

Things to remember:
