RETURNING TO SCHOOL

Everyone at Pondhu School is really looking forward to welcoming everyone back to school on Monday 8th March. There will be final details about the arrangements in next week's newsletter but here are some things you will need to know:

- The school day will start at 8.45am – please arrive 'just in time' for the start of the day. Please stay on site for as short a time as possible and only one person from a family to be collecting or delivering children to school. All adults on site will be expected to wear a face covering (unless exempt). Please remember to keep social distances at all times. Senior staff will be available at the school gate to take any messages for teachers or please telephone the office. The teachers will be focusing on getting the children back into school and will not be available to talk with you in the mornings.
- Full school uniform must be worn and please ensure everyone has a PE kit in school every day. We are planning to get outside and be active as much as possible.
- Pupils will be entering and leaving the school site using the same gates and entrances that we used last term. I will remind everyone next week of the specifics.

Next Monday, 1st March, the class Zoom sessions will be focusing on returning to school. Please encourage your child to join these sessions. Staff will be able to answer any questions they may have about coming back to school and this will help ensure the transition is as smooth as possible.

I am pleased to inform you that Mrs Newnes is expecting a baby soon (congratulations to her) and will not be returning to school in person. Mr Hatton will be teaching Year 2 from the 8th March. For the first few weeks I am pleased that Mrs Newnes will be able to teach remotely from home alongside Mr Hatton as this will help to ensure a smooth transfer for everyone.
